Pinelsle Golf Club at Lake Lanier Islands to Reopen

- WHO:** Pinelsle Golf Club at Lake Lanier Islands is reopening on April 1, 2006.
- WHAT:** Pinelsle Golf Club is one of Atlanta's most scenic courses. Designed in 1974 by Gary Player and Ron Kirby & Associates, the course has a rich history of golf tournaments such as LPGA tournaments and the 2005 Phil Niekro Charity Golf Classic in which two golfers in the same fivesome during the same round of golf hit two hole-in-ones.
- WHERE:** Pinelsle Golf Club is located at Lake Lanier Islands Resort, just 45 minutes north of Downtown Atlanta on the shores of Lake Lanier.
- WHEN:** Saturday, April 1, 2006
- WHY:** The course closed on November 4, 2005 for renovations and maintenance during the winter months, including bunker renovations, landscaping and a new fleet of 2006 Club Car Precedent golf carts. Fairways Grill will re-open as a casual sports bar and grille. The golf course, restaurant and pro shop will now operate under the same management as Emerald Pointe Golf Club at Lake Lanier Islands. "We are very excited to have Pinelsle and Emerald Pointe under the same management for the first time in the history of Lake Lanier Islands," said Rick Hileman, Director of Golf for Lake Lanier Islands.
