



FACT SHEET

- OVERVIEW:** Set on the pristine, southern-most shores of Lake Sidney Lanier is Lake Lanier Islands Resort. The year-round, 1,100-acre resort is located less than 45 miles from downtown Atlanta and boasts a variety of amenities and attractions.
- HISTORY:** Lake Lanier was formed in 1956 when the gates of the Buford Dam were lowered and the rushing waters of the Chattahoochee and Chestatee Rivers filled the valley. The entire process took two years, at a cost of \$45 million. Today, Lake Lanier is one of the most popular man-made lakes in the nation, covering 38,000 surface acres with 690 miles of shoreline.
- ACCOMMODATIONS:**
- Legacy Lodge & Conference Center**, formerly Emerald Pointe Hotel, is the centerpiece of Lake Lanier Islands Resort. Each of the 221 renovated guest rooms and suites overlook the area's scenery from a private patio or deck. It offers special event dining at Windows Restaurant, the poolside BullFrogs™ Bar & Grille, wireless internet access throughout the hotel, complimentary morning newspaper delivery and valet parking, a 24-hour fitness center, spa services, lighted tennis courts, walking trails, bicycle rentals, heated outdoor swimming pool, and 21,000 square feet of flexible meeting space.
- Legacy Villas** are set adjacent to the Legacy Lodge and offer all the luxuries of a modern resort with the privacy of a luxurious getaway. Each of the six, six-bedroom villas is individually keyed allowing guests to take as many or as few rooms as necessary. Each unit offers four bedrooms on the bottom floor and two suits on the top floor with common areas featuring hardwood floors, fieldstone fireplaces, wet bars and patios that overlook lake views.
- The LakeHouses at Legacy** offer all the conveniences of home, but with special touches that are unique to Lake Lanier Islands Resort. Each lake house features two bedrooms, two private baths with an adjacent dressing area, a large wooden deck with a heated spa and gas grill, a fieldstone fireplace, a modern kitchen, and sleeping accommodations for six.
- Houseboat Rentals** (from Harbor Landing) provide a luxurious getaway complete with a full kitchen, sleeping accommodations for 10, a heated Jacuzzi and waterslide on the top deck, a living area with satellite TV, a bath-and-a-half, central heat and air, and a gas grill. Houseboats are available for rental on a daily and weekly basis.
- RECREATION:**
- Pinelsle Golf Club** boasts 8 holes along the waters of Lake Lanier. Designed in 1974 by Gary Player and Ron Kirby & Associates, the Blue Ridge Mountains provide a magnificent backdrop. The Pro Shop carries all the top names in golf apparel, offers club rentals and the Lake Lanier Islands Golf Academy to assist in golf lessons. Fairways Grill overlooks the 18th green and Lake Lanier.
- Legacy Golf Club** is slated to open spring 2009 featuring a redesign by Billy Fuller and Medalist Golf of Atlanta. The design will feature 14 waterfront holes, completely renovated greens with new mini-verde Bermuda, larger tee boxes, Billy Bunker bunker design, longer course design, new concrete cart paths, state-of-the-art irrigation, new cart fleet, and will introduce a return to the Golden Era of Golf.

The Beach & WaterPark provides a number of water activities and leisurely fun for children and adults alike during the summertime, including a three-story, interactive water attraction, FunDunker®; Wild Waves, Georgia's largest wave pool; and the Kiddie Lagoon, which features Wiggle Waves, Georgia's only kid's wave pool. Open daily Memorial Day through Labor Day.

Harbor Landing has Lake Lanier's largest fleet of rental boats, including ski boats, pontoon boats, houseboats and group excursion yachts. Additionally, Harbor Landing provides a variety of fishing, tubing and ski equipment available for rent.

Equestrian Center offers scenic horseback trail rides, pony rides, riding lessons, summertime riding camps and an exclusive Ride & Romance package which features a private guided trail ride which leads to a picnic along the shore.

Tranquility Spa offers a repertoire of state-of-the-art facials, massages, body treatments and packages that can be customized for fit your needs.

Magical Nights of Lights is known as the world's largest animated light extravaganza. The six and a half mile driving tour features millions of twinkling animated holiday lights and a live nativity scene. The tour ends at the Holiday Village with amusement and pony rides, marshmallow roasts, holiday shopping and, of course, Santa Claus. Open mid-November through December.
